## **BUDGETPAK BROWSER SETTINGS TIPS**

## 1 Internet Explorer: How to suppress the "Do you want to allow this webpage to access your clipboard?" prompts

1. In IE, go to Tools -> Internet Options.



2. Click on the Security tab, then select the Internet zone, then click "Custom level..."

## 2 How can I have my BudgetPak login and password automatically filled in for me so I don't have to keep retyping them?

All browsers support remembering and pre-filling passwords, but in different ways.

There are also many third-party tools that keep your site logins and passwords in a "vault" and fill them in when you come to a site. One of the most popular is Lastpass: <u>https://lastpass.com/</u>

## 3 Safari: If reports do not run, uncheck popup blocker

Please make sure that Safari -> Preferences -> Security -> Block pop-up windows is UN-checked. (Although BudgetPak reports simply open in a new tab, not a popup window, Safari sometimes cannot seem to tell the difference.)
